WILLIAMSTOWN CITY COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
JANUARY 19, 2016

The Williamstown City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, January 19, 2016 at 7:30pm. Those in attendance were Mayor Jean Ford, Councilpersons Marty Seufer, Gene Duncan, Barbara Lewis, and Ron Erb, City Attorney Blaine Myers, and City Clerk/Treasurer Susan Knopp.

Mayor Ford called the meeting to order and Sgt. Jerry Ruble led Council in the Pledge of Allegiance.

On a motion by Lewis and second by Erb to approve and dispense with the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting, all voted yes.

On a motion by Erb and second by Lewis to approve the current bills for payment, all voted yes.

Mayor Ford announced the upcoming election on May 10, 2016 for mayor and two council seats. The filing period ends January 29th.

Mayor Ford stated that with the election coming up she believed council members should have a raise. Compared to other area cities, our council's salary is very low at \$1,000 per year. She said it is something we need to discuss.

Atty. Myers said a council member's salary cannot be raised during their term of office. With the staggered terms for council members, the two newly elected members would get the raise, but the other members would continue at their current salary until their term is up.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:36pm.
