WILLIAMSTOWN CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING APRIL 19, 2016

The Williamstown City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, April 19, 2016 at 7:30pm. Those in attendance were Mayor Jean Ford, Councilpersons Marty Seufer, Gene Duncan, Barbara Lewis, and Ron Erb, and City Clerk/Treasurer Susan Knopp. City Attorney Blaine Myers was absent.

Mayor Ford called the meeting to order and Sgt. at Arms Jeremy Raymond led Council in the Pledge of Allegiance.

On a motion by Lewis and second by Erb to approve and dispense with the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting, all voted yes.

On a motion by Erb and second by Lewis to approve the current bills for payment, all voted yes.

On a motion by Seufer and second by Erb to approve the Levy Rates for 2016-2017 as Class I = 12.5/\$100, Class II = 25.00/\$100, and Class IV = 50.00/\$100, all voted yes.

On a motion by Seufer and second by Lewis to adopt a budget revision for the 2015-2016 budget, all voted yes.

Three bids for the 2016 Street Paving Project were as follows: Brown Asphalt - \$166,067.29, Asphalt Contractors & Site Work Inc. - \$169,742.00 and Kelly Paving - \$139,124.00. On a motion by Seufer and second by Lewis to accept the bids for review, all voted yes.

Mayor Ford stated bids for the two Sidewalk Projects were opened today. The bids are being tabulated by the MOVRC and will be reviewed by the City Attorney. Council received a copy of the bidders and amounts.

Mayor Ford suggested cancelling the May 3rd meeting due to early voting equipment set up in the council room. Council agreed with cancelling the meeting, and a special meeting will be called in an emergency situation.

Councilwoman Lewis said the pool will open on Memorial Day.

Councilman Seufer stated a Park Committee meeting was held this evening. He said he would like to nominate Angela Joy to the Park Committee.

On a motion by Lewis and second by Duncan to appoint Angela Joy to the Park Committee, all voted yes.

Councilman Seufer stated a representative from the company that provided the park toys in Tomlinson Park will be coming to look at the equipment and give us an estimate on replacing or upgrading the current equipment. He said the Park Committee will come up with a replacement schedule.

Councilman Seufer said Dave Garcia, 201 Front Street, brought up the idea of creating a dog park in town. The Park Committee is looking at the property on the inside of the entrance to the boat ramp. There will not be a lot of expense for this project. The Park Committee will meet again before the next council meeting to discuss these projects.

Councilman Duncan said the Planning Commission met with the Taylors who want to put in a café inside the Woolen Willow. He said the Commission is waiting on the Taylors to provide some additional information on the proposed business.

Councilwoman Lewis said the Arbor Day Celebration will take place on April 28th at 1:30pm in the park shelter, or in the council room in case of rain. The fifth grade class from the elementary school will participate.

Councilman Erb said the Sanitary Board meeting was cancelled today, but the sewer line project on Rt. 14 is underway and will hopefully be completed in a couple of weeks. He said the Cullum sewer extension has also been completed.

After some discussion on the sidewalk projects, Councilman Erb stated the DOH is currently replacing sidewalks on Highland Ave.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:45pm.
